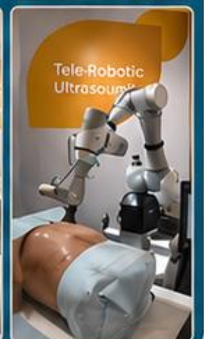
The participants worked on the latest robotic systems, used the VR system for education and had a meaningful, hands-on learning experience interacting with experts in robotic surgery.

The Breast Surgery Unit, Department of Surgical Oncology, in collaboration with the Department of Interventional Radiology at ACTREC, Tata Memorial Centre (TMC), Mumbai, successfully conducted the first-ever national Continuing Medical Education (CME) programme and live demonstration workshop on Chemoports and Totally Implantable Venous Access Devices (TIVADs) on 6th June 2026.

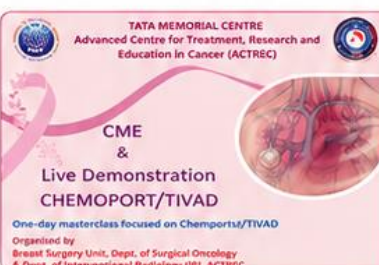
Endorsed by the Royal College of Surgeons of Glasgow (UK), the Indian Association of Endocrine Surgeons (IAES), and the Association of Breast Surgeons of India (ABSI), the programme focused exclusively on vascular access in oncology, a vital component of modern cancer care that often receives limited dedicated training. Bringing together specialists from multiple disciplines, the workshop provided a dynamic platform for discussion, skill-sharing, and real-world problem solving.

The one-day event attracted 36 delegates and 21 nursing professionals from institutions across India. Participants included surgeons, surgical oncologists, interventional radiologists, anaesthetists, residents, fellows, and oncology nurses who gathered to exchange knowledge and learn from experts in vascular access management.

A major highlight was the live demonstration of several chemoport insertion techniques. Faculty performed Adult TIVAD insertion, Pediatric TIVAD insertion, Arm Port insertion, Subclavian Port insertion, and Cephalic Vein Port insertion, allowing participants to observe procedures in real time and discuss technical considerations, planning, and troubleshooting.

Sessions covered indications for chemoport use, evidence supporting TIVADs in oncology practice, maintenance protocols, complication management, device removal, and pediatric vascular access considerations.

The meeting was highly interactive, insightful, and widely appreciated by all attendees. Many IAES Members were part of the Faculty, making this programme a valuable platform for multidisciplinary learning and collaboration.

The discussions were highly interactive and clinically relevant, providing valuable learning for all participants.

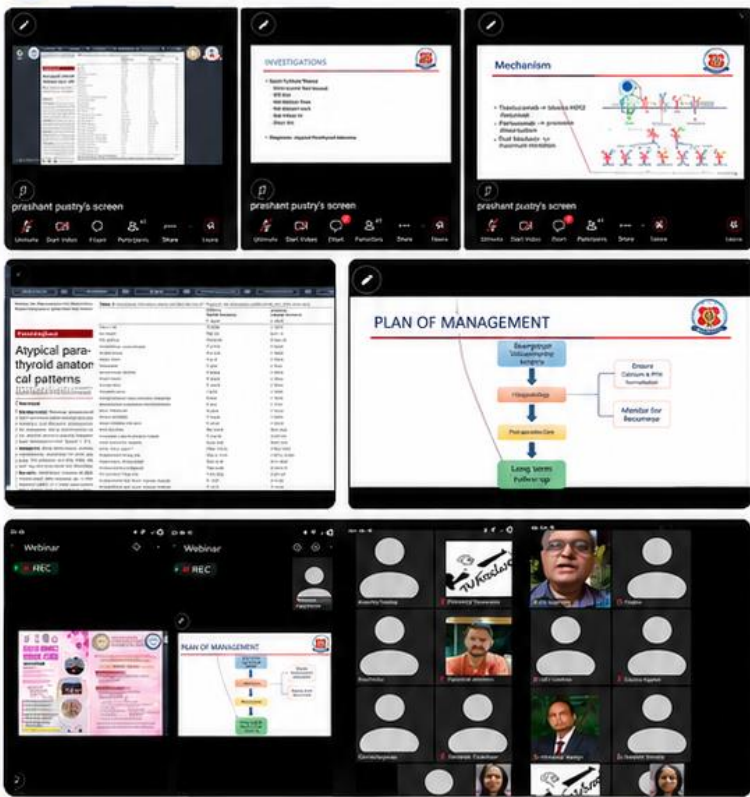
